## Job Description: Surgical Physician Assistant (PA) – Robotics Experience Preferred

Full-Time | Hospital-Based & Clinic-Based

We are seeking a highly skilled and motivated Physician Assistant to join our surgical team. This role offers a balanced mix of inpatient rounding, outpatient clinic, and operating room support, with a strong emphasis on teamwork, progressive responsibility, and long-term service line growth.

### Position Overview

The surgical PA will work collaboratively with multiple surgeons and an experienced APP team to support inpatient care, outpatient clinics, and surgical services. The role includes a structured onboarding period, gradual expansion of clinical responsibilities, and opportunities for advanced procedural and surgical involvement.

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### Schedule

- Monday–Friday; with occasional weekend call
  - Daily structure will consist of inpatient rounding, outpatient clinic, and surgical support; subject to evolution with onboarding and service line growth
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### Call Responsibilities

- Outpatient phone calls
  - Consults
  - First assisting in the operating room when applicable
  - One weekend per month
  - Call rotates with each surgeon once per quarter
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### Clinical Responsibilities

- Post-operative visits
- Wound care
- Same-day urgent visits
- Screening visits
- In-basket messaging and patient calls
- Medication refills
- Imaging orders
- Care coordination

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## Operating Room & Surgical Support

- First assisting in the OR as needed
  - Expectation to surgically cross-train to support OR coverage during provider availability challenges
  - Obtaining patient consent
  - Case preparation/discussion with implant representatives and OR
  - Patient positioning
  - Independent wound closure
  - Placing pre/postoperative orders and prescriptions
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## Team Collaboration & Workflow

- Daily sign-out to the partnering APP prior to clinic transition
  - Emphasis on communication, handoffs, and shared responsibility across the APP team
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## Qualifications

- Graduate of an accredited Physician Assistant program
  - NCCPA certification and eligibility for state licensure
  - Prior experience in general surgery or surgical subspecialties strongly preferred
  - Comfort with inpatient, outpatient, and OR environments
  - Strong clinical judgment, communication skills, and team-oriented mindset
  - Strong communication and patient education skills
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## Preferred Qualifications

- Prior OR and/or general surgery experience preferred but not required
