

## Job Description: Pain Solutions NP/PA

**Full-Time | Clinic-Based**

### Position Overview

The Pain Management Advanced Practice Provider (APP) functions as an integral member of the interdisciplinary pain management team, providing comprehensive evaluation, diagnosis, and treatment of patients with acute and chronic pain conditions. The APP practices in collaboration with the supervising physician and within the scope of state regulations and organizational policies.

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### Onboarding & Training

- Approximately 6-month onboarding period
  - Extensive shadowing and familiarization across both office visits and procedures at multiple locations
  - Progressive increase in autonomy as competencies are achieved

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### Call Responsibilities

- None
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### Clinical Responsibilities

- Conduct comprehensive patient assessments, including detailed pain history, physical examination, and review of diagnostic studies.
  - Diagnose and manage acute and chronic pain conditions (e.g., spine-related pain, neuropathic pain, post-surgical pain, musculoskeletal disorders).
  - Develop individualized, multimodal treatment plans incorporating pharmacologic and non-pharmacologic therapies.
  - Prescribe medications appropriately, including controlled substances, in compliance with state and federal regulations and internal opioid stewardship guidelines.
  - Perform or assist with in-office procedures within scope of practice (e.g., trigger point injections, joint injections, medication management follow-ups).
  - Monitor treatment effectiveness, adjust plans as needed, and manage medication refills and prior authorizations.
  - Identify red flags or complications and collaborate with supervising physician as indicated.
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## Patient Education & Engagement

- Educate patients and families on diagnosis, treatment options, medication risks/benefits, procedural expectations, and self-management strategies.
  - Provide counseling on safe opioid use, storage, tapering strategies, and alternative therapies.
  - Encourage functional restoration and lifestyle modification strategies to improve quality of life.
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## Care Coordination & Collaboration

- Collaborate with pain physicians, primary care providers, surgeons, behavioral health providers, physical therapy, and other specialists to ensure coordinated care.
  - Review and interpret imaging, lab results, and diagnostic studies relevant to pain management.
  - Communicate treatment plans and updates to referring providers.
  - Participate in interdisciplinary case reviews and quality improvement initiatives.
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## Documentation & Compliance

- Complete timely, accurate documentation in the electronic health record (EHR).
  - Ensure compliance with state prescribing regulations, PDMP checks, and internal policies.
  - Participate in quality metrics reporting and performance improvement activities.
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## Qualifications

- Graduate of an accredited Nurse Practitioner or Physician Assistant program.
- Current licensure as an NP or PA in the State of Ohio (or eligibility).
- National board certification (AANP, ANCC, NCCPA, etc.).
- Current DEA registration.
- BLS certification (ACLS preferred).

## Preferred Qualifications

- Prior experience in pain management, orthopedics, spine, neurology, or related specialty preferred.
  - Experience managing chronic pain and controlled substances strongly preferred.
